

The 13th Technical Meeting of NEAL-NET Was Held in China



The 13th Technical Meeting of NEAL-NET was held in Hangzhou, China during November 5th-7th, 2014. Delegates from Research Institute of Highway, MOT, National Public Information Platform for Transport & Logistics (LOGINK), NEAL-NET Secretariat members, government officials and technical experts of Japan and Korea, totally about 30 persons attended the meeting.

It is the first technical meeting since the Council Chair Country transferred from China to Japan on August 2014. As the first rotating Chair Country, China side earnestly fulfilled the obligations in the past four years. By the joint efforts of the Three Countries, NEAL-NET has made great achievement on formulating the standards of Dynamic Container Vessel Status and Container Status, and promoting the main ports of the Three Countries finished interface reform and joint test. The meeting focused on the working mechanism and technical problems.

The Three Countries discussed on how to establish effective Secretariat working mechanism and defined the work direction of next stage, and had in-depth

exploration on joint testing problems of NEAL-NET Unified User Management, NEAL-NET push service and ports logistics information interface trial.

The Three Countries achieved preliminary consensus on ports trail expanding, Unified User Management optimizing, NEAL-NET push service and other transport mode standards research, NEAL-NET working mechanism formulation, international cooperation promotion and next technical meeting relevant items, and finally signed the minutes of the meeting.
